

- 20 % Seats of Total intake are for institute level Admissions & 80% Seats of Total intake are as per CAP of DTE

As prescribed by DTE Rules for admission applicable in the current academic year 2016-2017

1. **ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE:**

- Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination other than the HSC (Std XII) examination of a divisional Board of Maharashtra state Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education will be required to produce at least a provisional statement of eligibility from the Registrar, University of Mumbai, declaring them eligible for admission to the first year, class of the B.E. degree course. The provisional statement of eligibility is issued by the Registrar of the University of Mumbai to a candidate who is prima-facie eligible for admission to the first year class of the B.E. Degree course on his/her making an application in prescribed form & payment of prescribed fee.
- The Blank Forms are available at college office.
- Students must submit the duly filled form back in the office & collect the Provisional Eligibility certificate from the college office.

ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility for Under Graduate (UG) programme in various categories is stated below:

2. **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION**

To be eligible for FE admission the candidate should have:

Maharashtra State Candidature Candidate :-

- The Candidate should be an Indian National.
- Passed H.S.C.(Std.XII) examination of State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects Physics, and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or Technical or Vocational subjects and obtained at least 50% marks i.e. 150 marks out of 300 marks & 45% marks i.e.135 marks out of 300 marks for backward class categories in the above Subject.

Or

Passed Diploma in Engineering and Technology and obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only);

Or

Passed B.Sc. Degree from Recognised University as defined by UGC and obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only);

- Obtained score mark in CET

3. All India Candidature Candidates, Jammu and Kashmir Migrant Candidature Candidates :-

- The Candidate should be an Indian National.
- Passed H.S.C.(Std.XII) or its equivalent examination with subjects Physics, and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry or Biotechnology or Biology or Technical or Vocational subjects and obtained at least 50% marks i.e. 150 marks out of 300 marks & 45% marks i.e.135 marks out of 300 marks for backward class categories in the above Subject.

Or

- Passed Diploma in Engineering and Technology and obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only);

Or

- Passed B.Sc. Degree from Recognised University as defined by UGC and obtained at least 50% marks (at least 45% marks in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only);
- Obtained score in CET or JEE Main Paper I .

4. Direct Second Year (Lateral Entry) -

For Maharashtra State Candidature and All India Candidature Candidates –

- Passed Diploma Course in Engineering and Technology with at least 45% marks ((at least 40% marks in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) in appropriate branch of

Engineering and Technology from an All India Council for Technical Education or Central or State Government approved Institution or its equivalent;

Or

- Passed B.Sc. Degree from Recognised University as defined by UGC or Association of Indian Universities and obtained at least 45% marks (at least 40% marks in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) and passed FSC with Mathematics as a subject Provided that students belonging to this category shall clear the subjects of Engineering Graphics /Engineering Drawing and Engineering Mechanics of the first year Engineering Program along with second year subjects.
- Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time.
- Besides above the eligibility criteria, The Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai is the Competent Authority for admission to First Year & Direct Second Year Engineering 2016-17. The updated information shall be available on DTE Website.
- Admission rules will be as per authority directing time to time from academic year 2016-17.

5. REPORTING FOR ADMISSION:

No application will be considered unless it is accompanied by the attested copies of the following documents.

Documents required for First Year Admission Under Institute Level

Indian Nationality: The certificate of Indian Nationality is part of the Domicile certificate, which is usually issued by the Tahsildar/Executive Magistrate/Dy. Collector of the concerned Taluka/District wherein the candidate ordinarily resides. In lieu of the "Certificate of Indian Nationality" any one of the following certificates/documents will also be acceptable.

- Indian Passport in the name of the candidate, issued by appropriate authorities.
- The School Leaving Certificate indicating the Nationality of the candidate as 'Indian'.
- Birth certificate of the candidate indicating the place of birth in India.
- Marksheet of SSC (Std. X) examination
- Marksheet of HSC (Std. XII)/ Diploma in Engineering / B.Sc Degree (All Semester).
- MHT-CET / JEE Main Score card 2016.
- Certificate of Indian Nationality of the candidate(Leaving Certificate /Birth Certificate/Passport Xerox)

6. **Indian Nationality:** The certificate of Indian Nationality is part of the Domicile certificate, which is usually issued by the Tahsildar/Executive Magistrate/Dy. Collector of the concerned Taluka/District wherein the candidate ordinarily resides. In lieu of the "Certificate of Indian Nationality" any one of the following certificates/documents will also be acceptable.

- Indian Passport in the name of the candidate, issued by appropriate authorities.
- The School Leaving Certificate indicating the Nationality of the candidate as 'Indian'.
- Birth certificate of the candidate indicating the place of birth in India.
- College Leaving Certificate
- Migration Certificate (in case of candidate passing qualifying exam. from any otherBoard other than Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & higher SecondaryEducation).
- Gap Certificate on stamp paper of Rs.20/- duly notarized. (This is for those candidates who have passed HSC/12th Standard in March 2015 or before and presently not studying in any course/institution)
- Domicile Certificate of candidate
- Physical Fitness Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner.

- AICTE Anti-Ragging Undertaking by Student as well as Parents on Rs.100/- non-judicial Stamp Paper.

7. Retention of Original Certificates:

If the candidate is offered admission, his or her original College Leaving Certificate (post qualifying examination) and Statement of Marks at the qualifying examination will be retained by the College. These two original certificates will not be returned to any candidate once admitted to a course unless the candidate cancels his or her admission or completes the entire course.

8. Mode of payment of fees:

The candidate who has been offered a seat in the college shall pay the prescribed fees in the form of D.D. (Demand Draft) should be drawn in favor of “Atharva College of Engineering”. The fees shall be paid by the admitted candidate during the process of admission as per the guidelines given.

The interim fee will be subject to change as per the decision of the “Shikshan Shulka Samiti”. Decision of Shikshan Shulka Samiti will be binding on the students.

9. University fees:

The candidate shall be required to pay any fees prescribed by the University from time to time.
