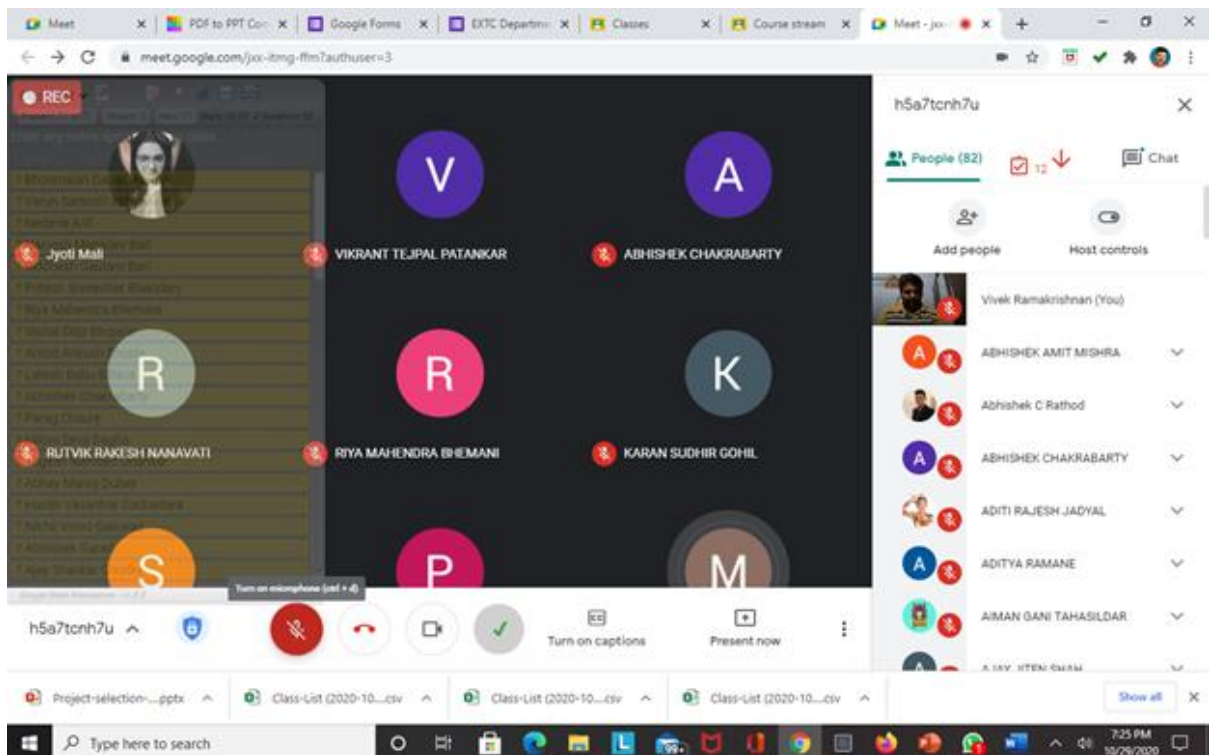
- What all skills are needed for doing the project.

5. Each participant was awarded a webinar certificate.

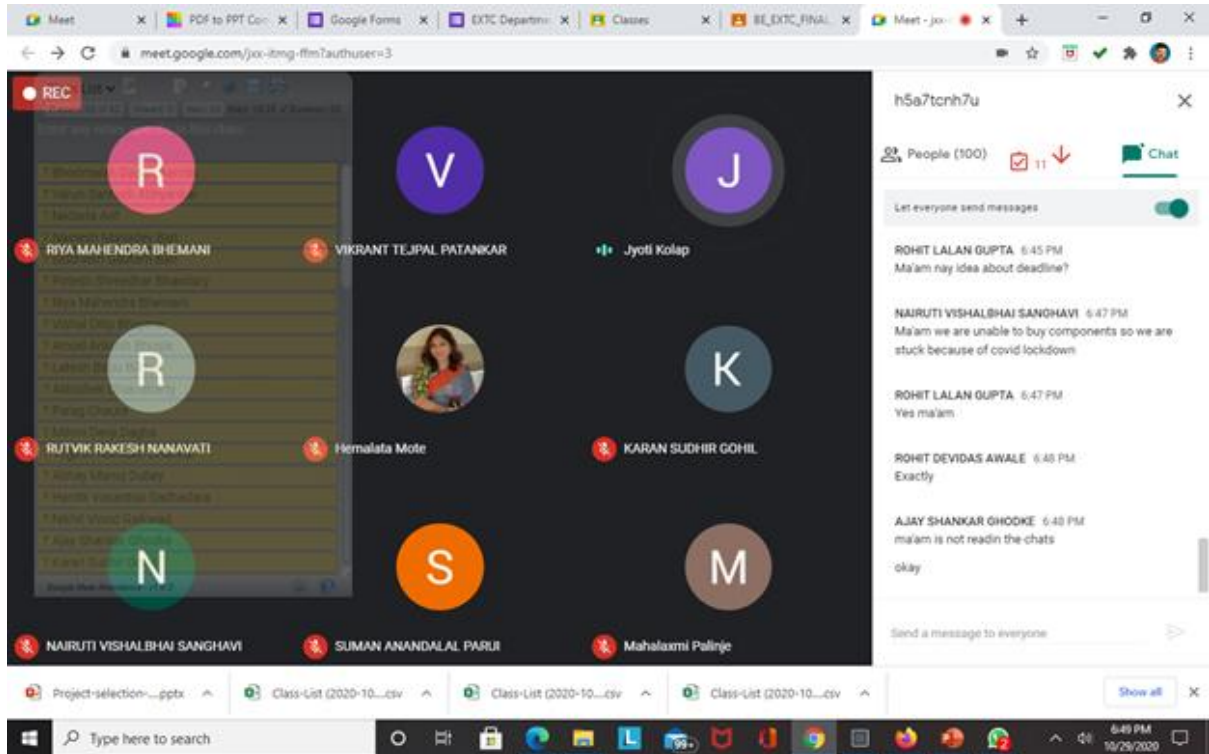
