Minutes of the meeting are as follow:

1. The meeting of NBA committee was started by Prof Rajendra Mahajan and he requested all departments' heads to introduce respective pre-qualifier. All the essential requirements and importance of pre-qualifier was discussed by Dr. Narayankhedkar.
2. Prof. Rajendra Mahajan requested Prof. Jyoti Kolap to present Pre-qualifier of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering Department. Prof. Supriya Dicholkar coordinator of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering Department presented Pre-qualifier. She started with basic information of the institute according to the format.



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3. Dr. Narayankhedkar suggested to present all admission data with proper specifications in students admission section. He also guided for considering academic years for evaluation.
4. Discussion was held on total number of faculty members of the respective department. Dr. Narayankhedkar discussed about student faculty ratio and suggested to verify data of all three years.
5. Dr. Narayankhedkar emphasized on three important mandatory requirements of pre-qualifier i.e. students admission, student faculty ratio and he stated that at least one Professor or one Associate Professor in each Department. He suggested that each department should have at least one Professor or one Associate Professor on regular basis with Ph.D. degree. He also discussed on 1:15 student faculty ratio for six years accreditation process.
6. The discussion was held on number of Ph.D. completed faculty members in a department. Dr. Narayankhedkar asked whether HODs possess Ph.D degrees for the programs under consideration and explained its importance.
7. Dr. Narayankhedkar suggested all department Heads to prepare data of respective departments according to the discussion.
